Historical James City County photographs are also being requested for display in the September exhibit. There is no entry fee for participants.



Categories are Farms & Working Lands; Rivers, Waterways & Farm Ponds; Native Flora & Fauna; Farm Animals & Wildlife; Farm Equipment; Rural Recreation; Rural Lifestyle; Rural Routes; Ugly Produce and Tremendous Timber.

All entries must be submitted to ruralphoto@jamescitycountyva.gov.

Entries are due by July 15, 2015 and each entry must include the entry form and if there are individuals in the photograph, there must be personal/minor release forms included. Any entry that does not include proper documents will be disqualified.
