

POPULAR PHOTOGRAPHY




Chris Tennant had a feature article published in the September issue of Popular Photography. The article included 8 of Chris' images as well as an awesome article of how to work with mother nature.

Bob Schamerhorn and Ken Conger had photos in the 2017 Virginia Wildlife calendar that came out last week. This is a pic of Bob with his two months.



On August 25, 2016, the National Park Service turns 100!


The Rules:
